Applicants for financial aid may be required to provide documentation to confirm that they are a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen. Listed below are the types of documents that may satisfy this requirement. If you submit photocopies of the required document(s), please be sure to submit clear and legible copies with your name and student ID at the top of the documents. If you prefer, you may bring originals of these documents to the Financial Aid & Scholarship Office for photocopying.

**U.S. CITIZEN (attach photocopy of the front side only)**

- Birth Certificate
- U.S. Passport (current or expired)
- Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570) or Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561)
- Form FS-240, FS-545, or DS-1350

**U.S. PERMANENT RESIDENT (attach photocopies of the front and back side)**

- Alien Registration Card I-551, I-151 or I-551C
- Passport stamped "Processed for I-551"
- Departure Report (Form I-94) stamped "Processed for I-551" or "Temporary Form I-551"

**OTHER ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZEN (attach photocopies of the front and back side)**

Attach a copy of your Departure Record (Form I-94 or I-94A) with a stamp indicating one of the following:

- "Refugee"
- "Asylum Granted"
- "Indefinite Parolee" and/or "Humanitarian Parolee"
- "Cuban-Haitian Entrant. Status Pending"

**NOTE: You are not eligible for federal or state student aid if you are:**

- An applicant for permanent resident status and not in a category listed above.
- A student with an F1, F2, J1, J2 or G series visa.
- A student in the United States with only a Form I-688 "Temporary Resident Card",
- Form I-688A or I-688B Employment Authorization.
